

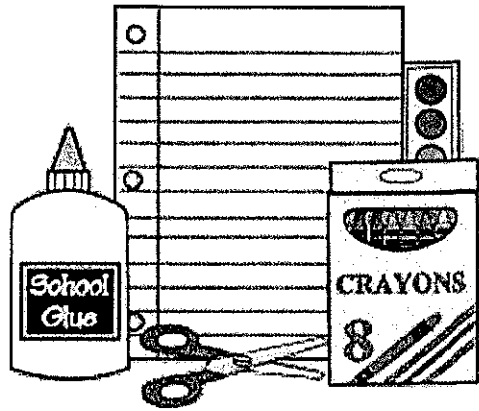
- 1 plastic pocket folder (should be sturdy as it will go back and forth to school each day)
- a backpack large enough to fit the folder (to go back and forth to school each day)
- a change of clothes (in a plastic zip-loc bag labeled with your child's name)
- 1 picture of your child
  
- Last Name A-K: 1 box of tissues
- Last Name L-N: a package of baby wipes
- Last Name O-Q: a box of snack size Ziploc bags
- Last Name R-T: a box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- Last Name U-Z: a box of sandwich size Ziploc bags



## **2020-2021 Kindergarten Supplies**

- 2 **plastic and pronged** pocket folders
- 1 plastic school supply box approximately 6" by 9" (no large ones)
- 12 pencils - Please sharpen at home if possible.
- (2) 24 packs of Crayola crayons - standard size and colors
- (1) 8 pack Crayola classic colors broad line **washable** markers
- (1) 4 oz. bottle of Elmer's white school glue
- 8 **jumbo size** (.77 oz.) Elmer's washable glue sticks  
(If you can't find this size, you will need 12 of the smaller ones.)
- (1) 100 page composition notebooks
- 2 large erasers
- 1 pair of Fiskars for kids scissors with metal blades
- a large zippered backpack (no wheels please)
- a bath size towel to use for rest time (no foam mats please)
- an adult size t-shirt for an art smock
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 package of baby wipes
- an extra set of clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks) in a plastic Ziploc bag, labeled with your child's name
- sneakers - We recommend that sneakers are worn **everyday**, not just on gym days.

This is the basic supply list. Individual teachers may request additional items. Your child will receive a letter from his/her teacher before kindergarten open house with a complete supply list if further items are needed. Please **label** all supplies except tissues and with your child's first and last name. A Sharpie marker works best for labeling. **Thank you for your cooperation!**



# First Grade Supply List

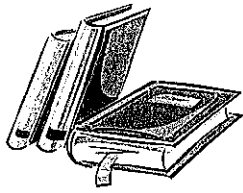
Dear New First Grader,

We are so excited to meet you! Here are the supplies that you will need to start the new school year off right!

- A backpack - no wheels please
- A plastic pencil box
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors
- An art smock or old T-shirt
- Sneakers - for PE days
- 2 pink erasers
- 3 pkgs. of 10 - #2 pencils - sharpened
- 3 boxes of Crayola crayons - 24 count
- 1 box of Crayola washable markers - 8 count
- 6 Large - .77 oz Elmers glue sticks
- 2 highlighters
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 5 - pocket folders with 3 prongs - plastic are preferred - one of each color: blue, red, yellow, purple and green
- 1 marbled composition notebook
- 1 box of small sandwich size Ziploc bags - **boys only**
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags - **girls only**
- 2 boxes of wipes
- 1 pair of headphones
- 6 black Expo markers

- 1 box of Crayola Markers
