Dear CHES Families,

By all accounts, the first trimester of the school year was a great success! The reopening of school far exceeded our expectations and that's a direct result of your support at home and the resiliency of our amazing students and staff. We will once again be put to the test as we enter a full remote model of instruction, effective Monday, November 23, 2020. In developing our comprehensive district-wide reopening plan, we planned and are prepared to implement high-quality remote teaching and learning for all of our students.

Some important items to note are listed below as they relate to the structure for remote learning at the elementary school. We are hopeful that this will be for a relatively short period of time and will soon return to in-person learning. Our goal is to make the transition as smooth as possible for our students and families.

- CHES will follow a “hybrid” approach to remote learning. The blue group will receive live, synchronous instruction on Mondays and Thursdays. The gold group will receive live, synchronous instruction on Tuesdays and Fridays.
- Live, synchronous instruction for both groups will be from approximately 9am-1pm. Attendance is required. Office hours, small group instruction, academic intervention services (if needed) will occur between approximately 1-3pm.
- The Wednesday schedule will remain the same. Attendance is required.
- Special area classes will be offered on the live, synchronous learning days.
- Detailed information with exact times and links will be forthcoming from your child’s teacher.
- ***Students currently enrolled in the Full Distance Learning model will continue with their schedule. There will be no change to the schedule for distance learners.***
