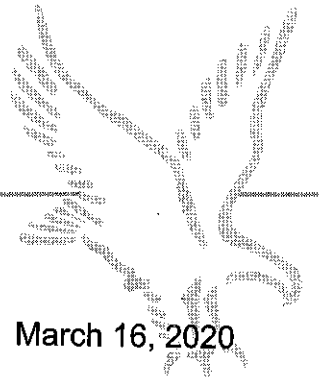

This is certainly a challenging and unprecedented time. As we enter into this period of extended school closure, our priorities remain on the safety, health, and welfare of our students and staff as well as on the continuity of education. Our teachers have been working extremely hard to identify meaningful and engaging 'Distance Learning' activities for your child to do while he or she is at home. All teachers will be posting/sharing assignments and instructional videos on a consistent basis, starting **Thursday, March 19, 2020**. Please be sure to frequently check email (or other platforms for communication) for more information from your child's teacher.

- Pick-up of instructional materials will take place this week on **Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 9:30-11:30, 1:00-3:00, and 4:00-6:00**. You will enter through the Eagle Entrance and exit through the doors in the Athletic Wing. No one will be permitted to go to lockers or classrooms.
- Students in grades PreK-2: Packets of work have been sent home. Teachers will communicate assignments to complete via email, Remind, or SeeSaw. Your child's teacher will let you know when additional packets are ready for pick-up.
- Students in grades 3-5: Assignments will be emailed to student Gmail accounts and/or posted on Google Classroom.
- All classroom teachers will set up conference times with students at least twice weekly.
- Activities related to the Special Areas (PE, Art, Music, Library) and Related Services (AIS, Speech, OT, PT, Counseling) will be communicated through the classroom teachers.

To tell you we will miss the students being in the building is a gross understatement. Please embrace this time with your children; share stories, engage in conversations, be creative, and most of all, enjoy being together. As always, thank you for your ongoing support. This is truly a special school community and one that I am extremely proud to be a part of.
